### 2 Samuel 15:13-23

1. ITTAI THE GITTITE: TRUE FRIENDS ARE L\_\_\_\_\_ TO EACH OTHER.

*Proverbs 18: 24 One who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother.*

2. ZADOK THE PRIEST: TRUE FRIENDS T\_\_\_\_\_ EACH OTHER.

3. HUSHAI THE ARCHITE: TRUE FRIENDS DO EACH OTHER F\_\_\_\_\_.

4. JOAB THE COMMANDER: TRUE FRIENDS ARE H\_\_\_\_\_ WITH EACH OTHER.

*Proverbs 27: 6 Wounds from a friend can be trusted, but an enemy multiplies kisses.*

### What can we learn from this message?

1. We are all blessed to have friends.
2. We need to be a good friend to our friends. Friendship is a two-way street.
3. Do you know who wants to be our friend?

*John 15: 13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command. 15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business.
